### The call

### An open door

With this in mind we believe that our Lord is calling us along with other believers to start a mission outreach fifteen minutes north of the city of San Fernando, México. "The Wilderness Camp" is about one hour south of Brownsville, Texas, and half an hour from the Gulf of México. On July 20<sup>th</sup> 2005, Hurricane Emily destroyed much of the area around San Fernando, northeast México. But in the midst of this disaster God has given us an open door.

### How should we pray?

"The Wilderness Camp" has 248 acres, and although many of the buildings were severely damaged, we are hoping and praying that soon we can rebuild it.

With your prayers and participation it will soon become an alternative school and training center for future pastors and teachers, missionaries and evangelists.

We are also praying that our Lord will send us the right families and the support needed to build this challenging ministry in northeast México.

### Why should we go?

It is evident that if we turn our backs on the Mexican crisis of the present day, that very soon their help will come from atheistic and communist countries that are eager to see México fall into their evil web (this was Fidel Castro's ultimate goal: to see a communist web through much of Central & South America in order to see the fall of the United States). Please consider all the ramifications of this dark future for México. We must do all we can to fight against this evil work, for many countries near & far have already fallen into this end-times trap.

We are hoping and praying for a few Bible believing churches and friends to come along side us:

#1. To help us restore the "Wilderness Camp" to a working ministry & outreach.

#2. To help us equip and train young believers to teach & preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

We truly believe what Dr. M. A. Thomas of India (with Hopegivers International) told us one day: "Train nationals in their nation."

We must be willing to live & share with our Mexican brothers & sisters with a true and living gospel based on the Biblical mandates. We must learn to live daily in fellowship like the brethren in Berea:

*"For they were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the Word with all readiness of mind, and searched the Scriptures daily, to see whether those things were so."* Acts 17:11 & I Corinthians 16:9.

Jesus told the unbelievers of His day: *"Search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life, and they are they which testify of Me."* (emphasis added) John 5:39.
